West Boylston Child Find

WEST BOYLSTON - The schools wish to identify all West Boylston children with disabilities, ages 3 to 21 years, who may be in need of special education services, and who have not graduated from high school.

Additionally, the school district wishes to identify any children who may be currently homeless and therefore have certain educational rights under the McKinney-Vento Homeless Education Assistance Act.

The McKinney-Vento Act was reauthorized by Congress in 2001 under the No Child Left Behind Act. It defines homeless children as those "who lack a fixed, regular and adequate nighttime residence."

Anyone who can identify a child with a disability or a child without a permanent home who is not receiving educational services, should have the parents or any interested person contact the West Boylston Special Education Department at 508-835-3391.

Pre-School Screening

WEST BOYLSTON - The West Boylston Public Schools will conduct a pre-school screening for all children ages 2½ to 4 years old on April 26, 2016 from 8am-1pm.

It is the policy of the West Boylston Public Schools to screen all students 2 ½ to 4 years old for preschool or prekindergarten who may be in need of special education services, when requested by the parents.
