Each student in grade five next year will need the following list of supplies. These items may be purchased the first week of school in September or purchased during the summer if you wish to avoid the crowds or the "sold out" status of some items.

MATERIALS NEEDED FOR ALL CLASSES:

1. Pencils (2 dozen #2)
2. Erasers (10 pencil top type and 3 pink erasers)
3. Ruler (12" standard/metric with three holes to clip into binder)
4. Pencil case with three holes to clip into binder (NO pencil boxes please)
5. Colored pencils (8 or more colors)
6. Scissors
7. Washable markers (1 package of 8 or 10)
8. \$12.00 (check payable to Edwards) to cover cost of map skills book, sticky notes, Cricket magazine, and Cobblestone magazine
9. Eight tab dividers (4 packages)
10. Clorox/Lysol wipes (3 canisters)
11. Tissues (3 boxes)
12. Paper towels (3 rolls)
13. Page protectors (20)
14. Glue sticks (12)
